Ray of Light begins with light passing through a tiny opening, then invites the reader to move the book around to see the light from different perspectives and understand where it is coming from. The **playful shapes** stimulate the imagination, accompanied by light's faithful companion – shadow.

The poetic text escorts and gently guides the reader through the experience.

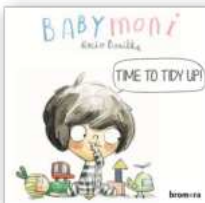

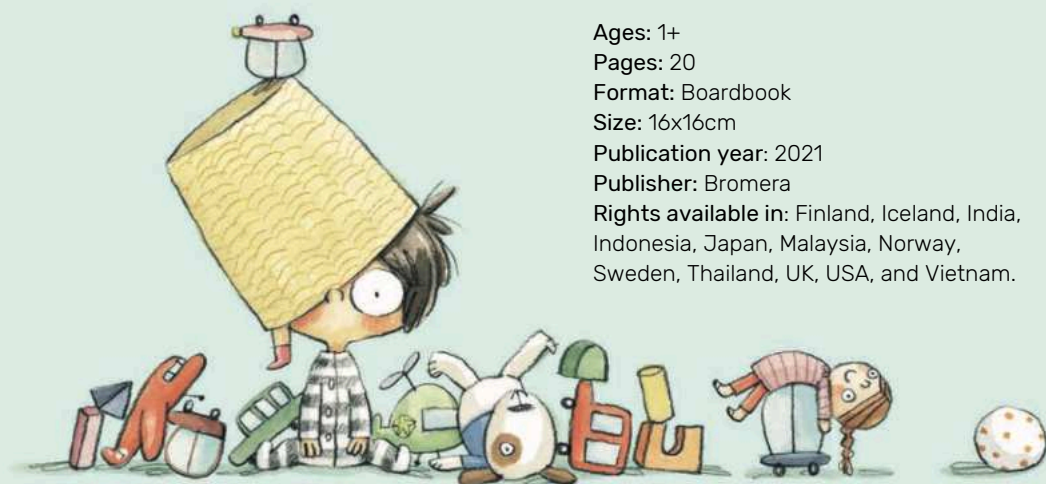
